Firefighter I

Salary Range: \$24,565 - \$35,398

General Duties and Responsibilities:

Perform specialized fire-fighting work in driving and operating firefighting equipment, combating and extinguishing fires, and maintaining equipment. Other duties include assisting with post-fire cleaning and salvage, cleaning fire station and grounds, and attending professional development training.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Must have knowledge and ability to operate firefighting equipment and administer first aid. Must have ability to communicate effectively with co-workers and the public.

Requirements:

Must have NC EMT certification or national registry. Completion of high school and some experience in firefighting, in driving a truck, or in maintaining equipment required. Must be in enrolled or have already completed some FFI and II classes. Must have a valid NC drivers license. This is considered very heavy work, requiring the physical ability to climb, balance, crouch, crawl, push, and lift in excess of 100 lbs. frequently.

Benefits:

11 Holidays; 10 Vacation Days; 12 Sick Days; Medical, Life, and Worker's Compensation Insurance; Retirement; Membership at City fitness facilities.

Hiring procedures:

All applicants for a Firefighter I position must submit an official City of Lenoir employment application to the Employment Security Commission or City of Lenoir Human Resources Department. Applications will be accepted at all times and will remain on file for one year. Job-related pre-employment tests and interviews will be conducted at least once a year. Pre-employment interview and test results will be documented and will remain valid for one year (or one testing phase, whichever is longer). These results will be the basis for filling Firefighter I position vacancies that may arise during the year following the interview/test date.
