## *What is the LPD-CPA?*

The Lenoir Police Department Citizens Police Academy is a eight week program designed to provide community residents with first-hand information about how their Police Department operates and why.

Participation in the CPA requires a commitment of one night a week for eight weeks, with classes meeting each Thursday night from 6 pm to 9 pm.

All classes are held in the Lenoir Police Department Training Room, unless otherwise specified, and are taught by experienced Lenoir Police Officers and State-Certified Law Enforcement Instructors.

- Communications
- Property & Evidence
- Patrol Procedures
- Criminal Investigations
- School-Based Programs
- Crime Prevention
- K-9
- Special Response Team
- Legal Issues of Policing
- Law Enforcement Firearms

Upon completion of the Academy, participants may choose to ride in a patrol car with an on-duty officer to experience, first hand, a day in the life of a Police Officer.

## *How do I apply?*

Applications are due by February 22, 2019.

The Lenoir Police Department will make every effort to involve people from all walks of life in this program. We encourage men and women, young and old to apply. First priority will be given to those applicants who reside or are employed inside the corporate limits of the City of Lenoir.

Participants must be 18 years of age or older with no criminal convictions other than minor traffic offenses.
