



## Mulberry Recreation & Martin Luther King Jr., Center Rules & Regulations



The following rules & regulations have been established to enable the facility to be used as a safe & enjoyable environment for all. Thank you for your cooperation & compliance.

1. Proper attire must be worn at all times. This includes approved pants, shirts, & gym shoes while in the gymnasium. Cleated shoes will not be allowed in the building.
2. Food & drinks will only be allowed in designated areas of the buildings. None will be allowed in the gymnasium or locker rooms. Smoking will not be allowed in any facility at any time. Beer, wine, alcoholic beverages, or illegal drugs are not allowed in the center or on the premises at any time.
3. All behavior will conform to wholesome recreational pursuits. Radios, portables stereos, hanging or swinging from rims, horseplay, back talking to supervisors, arguing, obscene, loud or abusive language, & fighting will not be tolerated.
4. All free play will be regulated by center staff. No free-play will be allowed during organized games & practices. Everyone 15 years of age & under must leave the center on school nights by 6:00pm unless accompanied by a parent or guardian or participating in a department activity. Individuals age 15 & under will not be permitted access to the facility during school hours unless participating in school or department organized activities.
5. Pets or animals are not allowed inside the facility except for legally recognized challenged individuals.
6. Knives, firearms, explosives, or other weapons are prohibited on these premises at all times.
7. All person or group violating the above rules suspended by recreation staff from the center & premises for any period of time based on the severity of the infraction. If a person or group is suspended from one recreation department facility, they are likewise automatically suspended from all recreation department facilities for the same time. People or groups notified by the recreation department of suspension who then attempt entry to any recreation facility or property will be considered trespassing & the Lenoir Police department has authorization to arrest violators. City of Lenoir may pursue criminal prosecution for violations of laws or city codes.
8. Dogs & Other Animals
  - (a) Dogs are not allowed on the property at the following facilities owned by the City of Lenoir: Mulberry Recreation Center, Martin Luther King Jr. Recreation Center, William B. Stronach Jr. Lenoir Aquatic and Fitness Center, Mack Cook Stadium, Lenoir Rotary Soccer Complex, and West End Park. These facilities have athletic fields, picnic shelters, restroom/concession buildings and playgrounds where children participate.
  - (b) Dogs are permitted at these facilities when approved classes are offered by the Parks and Recreation Department as well as K-9 classes and service animals. While in the class, dogs must be restrained by a leash not exceeding 6' in length and under the control of the owner at all times.
  - (c) Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
  - (d) No other animals are permitted in these parks.
9. LENOIR MUNICIPAL CODE ART. III SMOKING REGULATIONS - Sec. 13-62

Ordinance banning smoking in or on City of Lenoir buildings, Grounds, or vehicles is as follows: Smoking prohibited in City of Lenoir buildings, on City of Lenoir grounds or in City of Lenoir vehicles. No person shall smoke, carry or possess a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other lighted smoking equipment or paraphernalia in any City of Lenoir buildings, on City of Lenoir grounds, or in City of Lenoir vehicles except in designated smoking areas. Committing an infraction may be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00.)
