2021 Softball Registration forms can be filled out online or in person and turned in at Mulberry Recreation Center from 8:00am-5:00pm Monday-Friday. (Masks must be worn when registering athletes in person)

All Softball Athletes and Coaches will be required to wear masks during skill assessments, practices, and games, unless they have a medical exemption.

Registration Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup> - Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>.

\*Boys must be 6 years old on or before March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and cannot have turned age 13 before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

### **Softball: Girls Ages 6-12**

Registration Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup> - Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup>.

\*Girls must be 6 years old on or before March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and cannot have turned age 13 before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

### **Junior League: Ages 13-15**

Registration Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup> - Friday, April 30<sup>th</sup>.

\*Players cannot be age 16 before May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.

## Parents Code of Ethics

- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will provide support for coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco free sports environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaching, being a respectful fan, providing transportation, or whatever I am capable of doing.
- I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and agree that the coach agrees to the youth sports Coaches Code of Ethics.
- Note: All parents will be held accountable for their actions at all athletic events. If parents do not abide by this "Parents Code of Ethics", they will be asked to leave the premises immediately, and further actions may be taken.
